

- The scope is production of pharmaceuticals




What is the problem?

- Where and how pharmaceuticals are produced is confidential information
- Research show that pharmaceutical production often have a negative impact on nature in Asian countries

Step 1 - criteria on company level, based on public information



The company must report its sustainability work according to GRI Standards or some other international framework for sustainability reporting. The sustainability report must be audited by an independent party.


2 Membership Initiative (PSCI).* of PSCI

The company must be a member of the industry organisation, Pharmaceutical Supply Chain

*The company must have joined PSCI no later than 1 September 2022.





The outcome of the latest review of Well Selected

- Hugh interest from the industry and a lot of international meetings
- More companies have become members of PSCI
- More companies have developed their requirements towards suppliers
- Criteria requiring documentation a challenge for some to share, some are very transparent
- 205 articles/products from 10 companies (2024)
- Next upgrade of criteria in 2025





The next step


We want to develop the criteria further...
